TASK: design and implementation of an infrastructure database

This database will allow the MoniQA partner organisations to enter information about their infrastructure including specialised equipment or expertise. This resource will enable exchange and cooperation between the partners allowing them to, for example, test equipment in advance of purchase or process samples using equipment that is otherwise prohibitively expensive. Sharing of equipment will be subject to local rules and conditions established within the consortium agreement and any subsequent amendments. Thus, the database contributes to one of the key goals of MoniQA, namely the global integration of the participating partners.

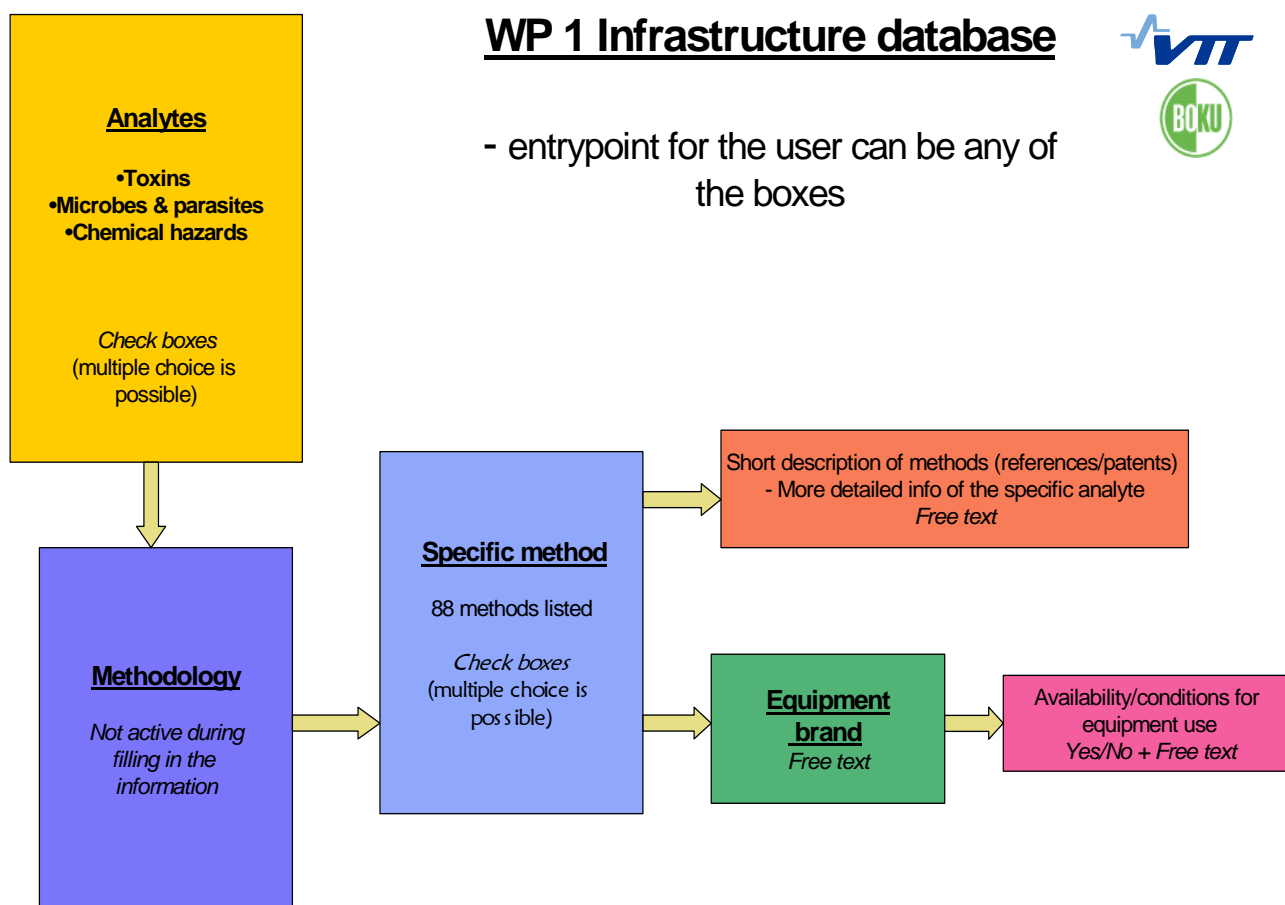
