Content Summary

A draft joint education/training concept has been prepared and was presented to the Management Board for approval prior to publication online for comment from by the members.

The draft concept consists of different modules. Some modules will be more relevant to industry whilst other are applicable to Universities and education. All courses in each module will be ECTS rated and depending on the total number of credits students will receive different awards. Credits will also be obtained by those attending selected workshops, conferences, or visiting partners for training.

The roadmap leading to the final training concept can be structured in six phases

- Phase 1: Collecting information from project partners
- Phase 2: Evaluation of the information on internal training
- Phase 3: Pilot run of training courses
- Phase 4: Draft training concept
- Phase 5: Collecting and analysis of information on external training
- Phase 6: Final Training Concept
